Budget-\$65,700

With that money we fund an Academic Interventionist, Kristi Gardner, who is doing tier 3 math interventions.

Money was allotted for a SEE student from Dixie State University. That appointment did not come through. Community Council has now requested a change for funding allocation to the Washington County School Board. It will be voted on tomorrow, Nov. 2, 2021. That money will now be utilized for technology, hardware and software for the school.

Trust Land money is also used to support the Americorp program which helps at risk children with reading.

There was a short discussion regarding the Harvest Hop and how well received it was by students, parents and families. Council is open to having more events like it.
