

Panorama Achiever Award (Grades 3-5)

The Panorama Achiever is an award that all students at Panorama can achieve! Students choose goals from the form and work towards these goals throughout the entire school year. It is a great way for students to learn valuable life skills and receive recognition for doing so. At the end of the year, students gather signatures from teachers and supervisors, proving their completion of each goal. Students are then recognized in a school wide assembly and their names will be printed on a banner that will hang in the lunchroom. Students will also be given a medal and celebrate with an ice cream party for their hard work. It is a great program that encourages Panorama students to go above and beyond!

Below we have included a brief explanation of some of the requirements. If you have more questions, your child's teacher can provide some clarity. Some of these events have already happened. Make sure to gather signatures for the requirements you have already completed. The deadline to turn in completed forms is Friday, April 21, 2023.

3rd-5th grade students are required to complete 10 of the goals by the deadline to receive the Panorama Achiever Award. There are a variety of options to choose from.

Read at least 3,500 minutes at home

To pass off this goal, students must submit their reading minutes weekly to their teacher.

Reading Fair

Reading Fair is held in January. Mrs. Madison will have packets available for students after Winter Break. Students choose a book and create a poster about the book.

Reflections Contest

Reflections is a PTA sponsored art contest. Entries are due October 17th. Students can submit artwork in a variety of categories, including 2-D art, 3-D art, photography, dance, literature, music, film, and others. Storytelling Festival

Storytelling Festival is an event that was held on October 6th. Students can recite a nursery rhyme (K-2) or a story (3-5) to an audience.

Science Fair

The Science Fair will be held in the Spring. All students are eligible to enter. More information will be sent home as the event approaches.

Read proficiently (based on Acadience PM) or be on track to make typical or above typical growth (according to Pathways of Progress).

The Acadience reading test is an assessment that is given to all students at Panorama at various times throughout the year. Students are Progress Monitored (PM) often—at least once a month. You can find out your students' results by asking your child's teacher. This requirement shows that students are reading on grade level or making sufficient progress each year.

Library Challenge

The library challenge is a 10 book reading challenge. All students can participate from reading picture books to chapter books. Library Challenge papers are in the library.

Attend Literacy Night/Math Night

Literacy Night was held October 6th. Math Night will be held in March. These are family events that are fun and engaging.

Fall Fair Entry

The Fall Fair is an event for 3rd grade students that is held in the fall each year. Students create an entry where they make, grow, or raise something and then present to fair attendees.

Multiplication Math Masters

4th and 5th grade students can become a Multiplication Math Master by studying their multiplication facts and then passing them off with Mr. Barrett.

Choir

3rd-5th grade students may participate in choir. It is held weekly on Tuesdays. Students that are in good standing (attend regularly) may pass this goal off. See Mrs. Searle or Mrs. Turner for more information.

Kindness Club

Kindness Club is held once a month after school. Students work together to do service projects for members of our school community.

Book Club

Book Club is an after school club available to 3rd-5th graders. Students will read a book on their own and then come to the meeting for a fun activity centered around the book.

Dance Club

3rd-5th grade students may participate in dance club. It is held weekly on Thursdays.

Students that are in good standing (attend regularly) may pass this goal off. See Mrs. Orr or Miss Jacobsen for more information.

Lexia

Lexia is an online literacy program that students at Panorama use to learn reading skills. 3rd grade students need to complete level 15.

Memorize a Monthly Planner Poem

3rd grade students can memorize one of the poems found in their monthly planner and pass it off with their teacher.

Biography Bottle

Biography Bottles are a 3rd grade project that will be explained in class. 3rd grade teachers have more information.

Knight of the Multiplication Tables

Students in 3rd grade can become a knight of the Multiplication Tables after passing off all of their multiplication facts during timed tests in class.

Animal Report/Utah Counties Report/Planet Report

For this requirement, 4th graders need to complete a project at home to go along with their report that was completed in class. Your child's teacher will send home information as the report is completed and projects are approaching. (Animal-late Fall; Utah Counties-after Winter Break; Planet-Spring)

Safety Patrol

Students in 4th and 5th grade can participate in Safety Patrol before and after school. These students help manage crosswalk safety in the parking lot of the school. Students sign up at the beginning of the school year.

Constitution Packet

5th grade students can memorize facts from the Constitution packet that they received in class. They will need to pass them off with their teacher.

Give Me Liberty Project

5th grade: There are 13 items that need to be passed off. The students need to memorize states, capitals, the Gettysburg Address, US Presidents, etc. This requirement is worth the equivalent of 4 goals.

Student Council

5th grade students that are on Student Council and fulfill all of their responsibilities can pass off this goal.
