Panorama Achiever Award (Grades 3-5)

The Panorama Achiever is an award that all students at Panorama can achieve! Students choose goals from the form and work towards these goals throughout the entire school year. It is a great way for students to learn valuable life skills and receive recognition for doing so. At the end of the year, students gather signatures from teachers and supervisors, proving their completion of each goal. Students are then recognized in a school wide assembly and their names will be printed on a banner that will hang in the lunchroom. Students will also be given a medal and celebrate with an ice cream party for their hard work. It is a great program that encourages Panorama students to go above and beyond!

Below we have included a brief explanation of some of the requirements. If you have more questions, your child's teacher can provide some clarity. Some of these events have already happened. Make sure to gather signatures for the requirements you have already completed. The deadline to turn in completed forms is Friday, May 2, 2025.

3rd-5th grade students are required to complete 10 of the goals by the deadline to receive the Panorama Achiever Award. There are a variety of options to choose from.

Read at least 3,000 minutes at home

To pass off this goal, students must submit their reading minutes weekly to their teacher.

Reading Fair

Reading Fair is held in January. Mrs. Madison will have packets available for students after Winter Break. Students choose a book and create a poster about the book.

Reflections Contest

Reflections is a PTA sponsored art contest. Entries are due at the end of October. Students can submit artwork in a variety of categories, including 2-D art, 3-D art, photography, dance, literature, music, film, and others. Storytelling Festival

Storytelling Festival is an event that will be held in October. Students can recite a nursery rhyme (K-2) or a story (3-5) to an audience.

Science Fair

The Science Fair will be held in the Spring. All students are eligible to enter. More information will be sent home as the event approaches.

Read proficiently (based on Acadience PM) or be on track to make typical or above typical growth (according to Pathways of Progress).

The Acadience reading test is an assessment that is given to all students at Panorama at various times throughout the year. Students are Progress Monitored (PM) often-at least once a month. You can find out your students' results by asking your child's teacher. This requirement shows that students are reading on grade level or making sufficient progress each year.

Library Challenge

Library Challenge papers are in the library. Students that read the books to pass this challenge can earn this goal.

Attend Literacy Night and/or Math/STEM Night

These are family events that are fun and engaging. Dates will be announced as they are approaching.

Multiplication Math Masters

3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students can become a Multiplication Math Master by studying their multiplication facts and then passing them off.

Kindness Club

Kindness Club is held once a month after school. Students work together to do service projects for members of our school community.

Book Club

Book Club is an after school club available to 3rd-5th graders. Students will read a book on their own and then come to the meeting for a fun activity centered around the book.

Dance Club

3rd-5th grade students may participate in dance club. It is held weekly. Students that are in good standing (attend regularly) may pass this goal off. See Mrs. Orr or Miss Jacobsen for more information.

Choir

Students that are in good standing (attend regularly) may pass this goal off. See Mrs.

Beecher for more information.

Lexia

Lexia is an online literacy program that students at Panorama use to learn reading skills.

3rd grade students need to complete level 15.

Biography Bottle

Biography Bottles are a 3rd grade project that will be explained in class. 3rd grade teachers have more information.

Knight of the Multiplication Tables

Students in 3rd grade can become a knight of the Multiplication Tables after passing off all of their multiplication facts during timed tests in class.

Memorize the Preamble

3rd grade students need to memorize the Preamble of the Constitution and pass it off with their teacher.

Utah Heritage Award

4th grade students can learn facts about the state of Utah to earn this award. See your 4th grade teacher for more information.

Safety Patrol

Students in 4th grade can participate in Safety Patrol before and after school. These students help manage crosswalk safety in the parking lot of the school. Students sign up at the beginning of the school year.

Patriot Award Project

5th grade students can learn facts about the constitution and our country. Students who complete this project can count this as **4 goals**. See your 5th grade teacher for more information.

Student Council

5th grade students that are on Student Council and fulfill all of their responsibilities can pass off this goal.

Life Skills Tutor

Students that have volunteered to be a Life Skills Tutor and are in good standing can earn this goal.
