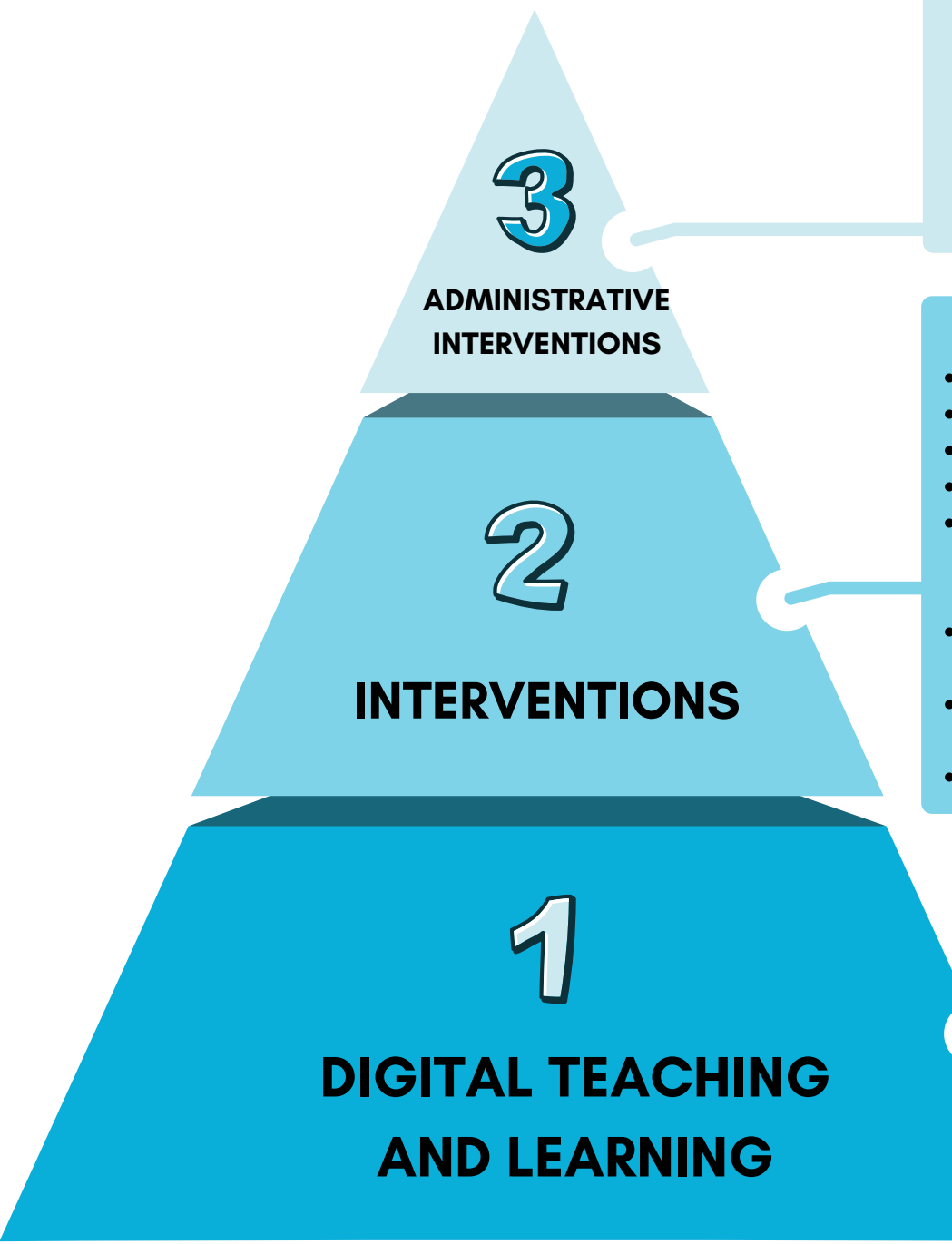


Digital CITIZENSHIP

- Teacher**
- Logs the incident
 - Automatically refer student to the office for administrative intervention

- Administration**
- Notify parent / guardian
 - Meet with parent/guardian and student
 - Develop digital citizenship integration plan.

- Continued Violations**
- Teacher logs incident and notifies administration.
 - Admin. notifies parent/guardian
 - Student suspended from classroom devices for the remainder of the year, except for testing.

- Minor Incidents**
- Student chooses not to stay on approved websites or programs.
 - Student searches and plays games instead of doing assigned work.
 - Student changes computer settings (color, contrast, background etc.).
 - Student "toys" with headphones.
 - Student disrupts another student's work by playing with their computer - messing with the keyboard, closing the screen, or taking the computer away.
 - Student uses the computer to access and participate in chat rooms, social media, and testing platforms.
 - Student chooses to hid laptop screen from teacher or use the laptop in an unapproved location.
 - Student logs in to a personal (non - @washk12.org) email.

- Major Incidents**
- Student abuses the computer by removing keys, adding or removing stickers, or damaging the equipment.
 - Student logs in with another student's username/password.
 - Student has personal devices out in the open and not in their backpack.
 - Student uses technology to type and/or search inappropriate content such as foul language, private body parts, etc.
 - Student uses technology to engage in cyber-bullying or other forms of harassment (automatic tier 3 intervention).
 - Student uses technology to search and/or view inappropriate content such as pornography, violent acts, etc. (automatic tier 3 intervention).

- Teachers**
- Monitor students using technology.
 - Teach Digital Citizenship.
 - Provide students access to technology tools for learning.
 - Review rules and consequences.
 - Ensure students are using technology at their desks (student desks).

- Students**
- Have access to technology for learning.
 - Practice good Digital Citizenship.
 - Follow teacher instructions when redirected to learning tasks.
 - Students will not use personal devices that can access the internet at school or on the bus.
 - Devices such as phones will be kept in backpacks with the ringer turned off during school hours.
 - A smart watch or watch-phone can be worn by a student in the class as long as it does not ring, no games are played, or it becomes a distraction.
